Satan's Tactics – The War for our Hearts and Souls

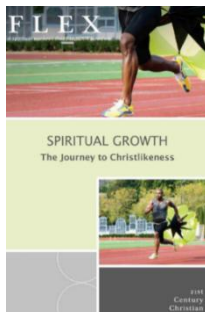
The wise traveler in this world understands that a deadly predator is always stalking. He preys, not on flesh and blood, but on souls and eternal spirits.

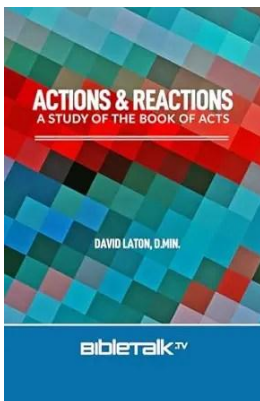

Journey to Hope

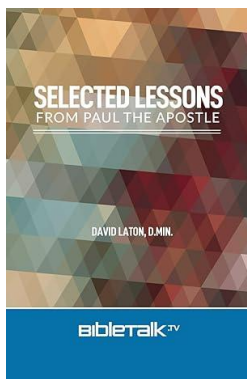

This study looks at significant events in the first century church found in the book of Acts and how they impact the church today.

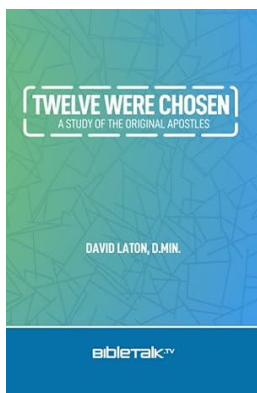
It is excellent for Bible classes, small group studies, and individual studies.
